

## 11674 Obsidian

Finely ground grey powder: 0 – 120  $\mu$

Obsidian is a natural black volcanic glass.

The mineral rocks are found in Arizona and Northern Mexico and produce a fine, subtle grey powder.

Obsidian consists of approx. 75.5% SiO<sub>2</sub>, 14.11% Al<sub>2</sub>O<sub>3</sub>, 1.74% Fe<sub>2</sub>O<sub>3</sub>, 0.78% CaO, 3.92% Na<sub>2</sub>O, 3.63% K<sub>2</sub>O and 0.39% H<sub>2</sub>O.
