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inert dusts may impair respiratory organ functions. The individual test results were as follows: skin tolerance (rabbit): no irritant effect; eye irritation test (rabbit): no irritant effect; LD₅₀ (oral, rat): not determinable; all animals still alive after 5,000 mg/kg.

Remarks : Subchronic toxicity (rat): no appreciable findings up to 20 000 ppm.
